WHAT'S HAPPENING?



A pending change to provincial health legislation would allow dental hygienists to practice independently of employment or contract with a dentist.

To implement this change, the College of Dental Hygienists of Saskatchewan (CDHS) is seeking input on new requirements to practice aimed to ensure safe, quality care.

CURRENT STATE

Approximately 3% of dental hygienists in Saskatchewan practice *independently* (self-employed) under a contract agreement with a dentist.



PROPOSED

Dental hygienists would apply for approval from the College to practice *independently*, and meet the additional requirements set out in the proposed bylaw amendments



EXEMPTIONS

Dental hygienists practising as employees will not be impacted by this change.



WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

- Consultation feedback will be reviewed and compiled
- CDHS Council will approve the amendments for the next phase
- Proposed amendments be submitted to Ministry of Health, Government of Saskatchewan for approval and enactment
- Repeal of Section 25 of the Dental Disciplines Act and accompanying bylaw changes to be implemented
